
SUBJECT: Release of Package Three of updated Medical Impairment Assessment (MIA) forms for assessing compensation claims under the MRCA and VEA.

Purpose: To inform CBD staff of an additional fourteen updated MIA forms that replace the existing forms used when requesting medical evidence for assessing compensation claims.

Key Points:

- The Claims Processing Improvement Division (CPID) has continued the review of existing forms and consolidated a further thirty-four forms to fourteen forms, which are now available for use.
- The fourteen new consolidated MIAs are available on the [Compensation Claims Support Site under the Medical Impairment Assessment \(MIA\) tile](#) and the DVA Medical Provider webpage ([For providers | Department of Veterans' Affairs \(dva.gov.au\)](#))
- Delegates and CSOs will need to continue to manually insert the applicable form/s into the Provider Medical Appointment letter until the new forms have been uploaded into R&C ISH.
